Addendum to the 2023-2026 Institutional Catalog

Our 2023-2026 Institutional Catalog on page 10 presents the following information regarding the authorization from the Puerto Rico Board of Postsecondary Institutions.

In August 1980, the Seminario Evangélico de Puerto Rico (SEPR) began offering, in addition to the Master in Divinity (M.Div.) program for pastoral leadership training, the Master of Arts in Religion (M.A.R.) program. The Seminary currently offers a Doctor in Ministry in Pastoral Care of the Family. In 2022, it received approval from the Association of Theological Schools of the United States and Canada (ATS) and the Puerto Rico Board of Postsecondary Institutions to offer the Master of Arts in Biblical and Theological Studies and the Master of Arts in Christian Education and Formation. In August 2023, it began offering the Master in Counseling in Family, Couple, and Marriage. It also offers a Continuing Education Program as an alternative for pastors, lay leaders, and various faith communities. In this way, the Seminary responds to the demand of a growing number of people interested in deepening their faith and better serving their congregations. their communities, without aspiring to professional ministry. Throughout these years, the Seminary, with its academic offerings, has attracted individuals interested in teaching religion in educational institutions, pursuing advanced studies in the areas of theology and religion, and researching the religious phenomenon in Puerto Rico.”

The Addendum is as follows:

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In accordance with the requirements established in Regulation No. 9272 of the Puerto Rico Board of Postsecondary Institutions dated April 23, 2021, the Master in Divinity (M.Div.) and Doctor in Ministry in Pastoral Care of the Family (DMin) programs are currently under evaluation to obtain the corresponding authorization from the Puerto Rico Board of Postsecondary Institutions. Historically, these biblical and theological programs did not require such authorization; however, because of the provisions of the current regulations, the SEPR has initiated and is currently processing the corresponding application with the Board of Postsecondary Institutions. Consequently, at the time of publication of this catalog, these programs do not have the authorization of the Board of Postsecondary Institutions to be offered by SEPR.

This addendum is effective as of July 16, 2026.
